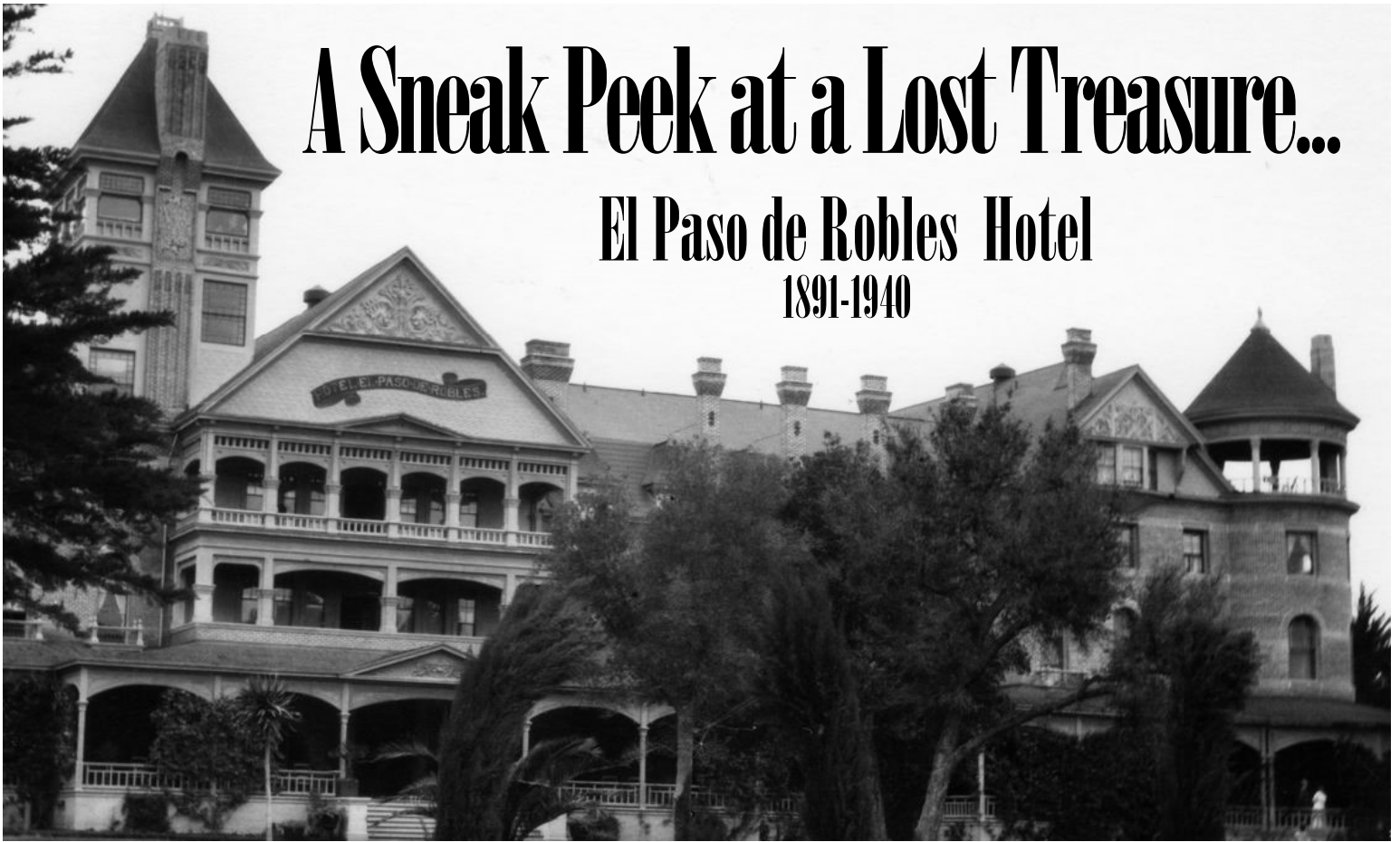


A Sneak Peek at a Lost Treasure...

El Paso de Robles Hotel 1891-1940



Saturday, September 10th from 4:30 p.m.—7:30 p.m. at the Pioneer Museum

The Pioneer Museum invites you to see history in the re-making. The Museum is in the process of re-creating a 1/3 scale model of the El Paso de Robles Hotel. This model will cover the majority of one end wall of the Museum and is the largest exhibit built by our all-volunteer construction crew. When complete, the exhibit will be 15 ft. tall and 30 ft. wide and will re-create the famous entrance to the Hotel. Visitors will be able to enter the porch area and view artifacts and photos from the old Hotel and get a sense of the grandeur that greeted Hotel visitors of the day.
